Project Scope

Health Care is one of the important determinant in promoting general physical health and well- being of people. According to the National Family Health Survey of the Government of India access to medical health care is still a major challenge for the local under privileged community.

Health statistics of rural India continue to be poor, the health status and access to health for the poor in the urban slum dwellers has surfaced to be equally deplorable.

In Himachal Pradesh about 89.9%¹ of the population of the state lives in rural areas. People have to travel long distances to cities for receiving proper medical care. Though there has been substantial progress on the health and family welfare indicators of Himachal Pradesh, but still there is a wide scope to support the population on Maternal and child health (MCH) programme, non-communicable diseases as well as other vulnerabilities.

In proportion of the population living in rural areas of Paonta Sahib medical facilities are not adequate for their healthcare. This project is being funded and monitored by Mankind Pharma Limited and has been implemented to complement patients in rural area. This initiative had made good impact in lives of people. This project is a long term initiative of Mankind Pharma Limited to support local communities in and around Paonta Sahib to enable them to get quality healthcare facilities at affordable price.
